All Our Readings

Our students are welcome to move between courses as they please – provided that they have the same frequency and price. For example, it is possible for someone to follow the **Novels Advanced** course for two months (The Great Gatsby and The Gambler), then move to the **Novels Big Reads** for another two months (Pride and Prejudice), and finish the last one at the **Novels Intermediate** course (Ethan Frome). Similarly, if he or she wishes, a student from the **Short Stories** course is free to change to the **Read in Class** for some time – and vice-versa. The flexibility is intended to help our students follow **their personal interests** and **manage the amount of time** they have available to read.
